Peer Review of Procedures Ensures Quality Control at Montserrat

As many of our referring GP's know, Montserrat records all of our endoscopy procedures from start to finish at all facilities. This unique Quality control aspect of our service has been standard for many years.

Whilst other devices used in endoscopies allow photo's to be taken of significant milestones achieved during the endoscopy (and colonoscopy in particular) they do not allow a full review of the procedure to be undertaken. Whilst formally retired I continue to undertake blind reviews of approximately 20 full DVD's every quarter to determine that :

- a) The bowel preparation was excellent
- b) The endoscopy technique was competent
- c) The view during the endoscopy matches the patient and GP report; and importantly
- d) The withdrawal time undertaken by the proceduralist was at least 6 minutes from the caecum.

Additionally, via our Medical Advisory Committee and Clinical Practice meetings we review other important measures of quality such as:

- a) Adenoma detection rates
- b) Quality of bowel preparation
- c) Patient Satisfaction and feedback
- d) Any significant episodes that require transfer to acute facility; and
- e) Any best practice changes that require us to modify any of our operating protocols (such as appropriate recall intervals)

We believe that all of these quality measures sets us apart, allows us flexibility to respond quickly to any issues, and sets the framework for excellent patient outcomes.

My name is Cathy Apelt and I am privileged to be a McGrath Breast Care Nurse.



The McGrath Foundation was co-founded by Jane McGrath and her cricketing husband Glenn after Jane's personal experience with breast cancer. It was this experience that led her to believe that the McGrath Foundation should raise money to place McGrath Breast Care Nurses in community's right across Australia and to increase breast awareness in young Australian women. Jane's breast cancer diagnosis at only 31 made her passionate about encouraging all women, including younger women (under 40), to be breast aware by regularly checking their breasts for any changes.

The McGrath Foundation's breast awareness initiative, Curve Lurve, has been developed to ensure the next generation of Australian women are breast aware. Also if you are a woman and over 40 I would encourage you to have a mammogram. If you know any women over 40 then I would encourage you to start an appropriate conversation about mammograms. Contact for Breast Screen Old is13 20 50. I am a registered nurse and had a long history working in community cancer care before commencing in 2 half time positions with the McGrath Foundation. So 5 days a fortnight I am based at Nambour General Hospital and the other 5 days I am based at the Sunshine Coast Haematology and Oncology Clinic / Montserrat rooms at Cotton Tree on the Sunshine Coast. This is a free service. The position is here to help anyone diagnosed with breast cancer. Therefore I am talking to people (I am talking to a couple of men with breast cancer at present, so trying to be gender neutral!), from the Margate/Redcliffe area north to Pomona.

Hopefully I can help patients and their families understand any technical or complex information about breast cancer to enable appropriate treatment and management. Also I have liaised with other organizations and gathered information about support services appropriate for the breast cancer experience.
